“Celebrate Braselton!” Parade Guidelines Wednesday, July 4th, 2018, at 6pm

Thank you for your interest in participating in the 4th of July Celebrate Braselton parade. Below you will find a registration form. If you have any questions please contact Amy Pinnell at 706-684-0369 or apinnell@braselton.net.

Please review the parade guidelines and share with everyone participating in your entry.

The parade will begin promptly at 6pm on Wednesday, July 4th. Line up begins at the Braselton Tech Center (home to YearOne and Northeast Church) located off Hwy 53 at 5pm. **Please note: Use the Hwy 53 entrance only as other entrances will be blocked or exits only.**

The parade route will be along Hwy 53 beginning at the Tech Center, turning right onto Henry Street (before the old Primary School), continuing on to Harrison Street by Braselton Park, turning left onto Davis Street then right onto Hwy 124 where we will make a final left turn back to the Tech Center.

Guidelines

1. The parade committee will review all entries and will approve or disapprove according to these regulations.
2. A portable generator can be used on a float but must be securely on the float and must have a dry chemical fire extinguisher on board.
3. All motorized vehicles must be driven by properly licensed drivers over the age of 18.
4. Candy can be gently tossed from vehicles or floats by adults only.
5. Walkers handing out items should keep up with the pace of the parade. Vehicles should not stop along the route. Drivers and passengers should never exit vehicles unless there is an emergency.
6. Participants can begin arriving at the Tech Center no earlier than 5pm but must be checked in and in assigned position by 5:45pm.
7. In the staging area, vehicles must be attended by a driver at all times.
8. All drivers should attend a safety meeting at 5:50pm.
9. In cases of inclement weather: the parade will only be canceled if the Braselton Police Department deems, based on local weather advisors, that conditions outside will be unsafe.
10. All entries need to be pre-registered. **No day of parade entries will be allowed.**
11. There are no restroom facilities available at the staging area.
