Council Meeting Minutes  
August 12, 2019

The Town of Braselton met for its regular meeting on Monday, August 12, 2019.

Mayor Bill Orr called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Council members present were Peggy Slappey, Becky Richardson, Hardy Johnson and Tony Funari.

Mayor Orr led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilmember Funari made a motion to approve the minutes of the meeting from July 8, 2019. Councilmember Johnson seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Joy Basham spoke during citizen comment about the intersection of 211 and Thompson Mill and improvements she wants Gwinnett County and GDOT to make.

Councilmember Johnson made a motion to send back to Planning Commission Applications 18-11-RZ and 18-06-VAR for an August 26<sup>th</sup> hearing and recommendation to Council on the revised plan. Councilmember Funari seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
