

**AN ORDINANCE AND/OR RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF BRASELTON TO AMEND IT ALCOHOL BEVERAGE
CODE CONCERNING HOUSE OF SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY
THE DRINK; AND OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the Town of Braselton conducted a special election on November 6, 2018, concerning the regulation of hours of Sunday sales of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises; and

WHEREAS, such ballot question was approved as follows, to wit:

YES 357 votes

NO 180 votes

Thereby allowing alcohol sales by the drink to commence at 11:00 o' clock a.m. on Sundays;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF BRASELTON, A GEORGIA MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

The Town of Braselton's Alcohol Beverage Ordinance, Section 11 "Hours of Sale" as set forth in its Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

Hours of Sale. A. For the sale of alcoholic beverage at retail and not for consumption on the premises: 7:00 a.m. to 11:55 p.m., Monday through Saturday, and on Sunday between the hours of 12:30 p.m. and 11:30 p.m. (Amended November 8, 2010) B. For the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption by the drink on the premises of an inn or restaurant where sold, 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m., Monday through Friday; 7:00 a.m to 2:00 a.m., Friday to Saturday morning and Saturday to Sunday Morning; ~~and 12:30 p.m.~~ 11:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, provided however a resort as defined below may sell such alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises until 3:00 a.m., Monday through Saturday. For the purposes of this Section, an "eating establishment" means an establishment which is licensed to sell distilled spirits, malt beverages, or wines and which derives at least 50 percent of its total annual gross food and beverage sales from the sale of prepared meals or food, and an "inn" means an establishment which is licensed to sell distilled spirits, malt beverages or wines and which derives at least 50 percent of its total

annual gross income from the rental of rooms for overnight lodging. For the purposes of this Section “resort” means a property containing more than 100 rooms for sleeping accommodations with additional amenities and more than one restaurant on premises.
